Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Football ^{team} class/club has decided to sell Hornet Cards as a fundraiser to support team equipment/uniform needs. Certain guidelines are necessary and we ask that you read this carefully and review it with your student before the sale begins. The sale will be start 5/26/16 and end 6/6/16.

- ✓ Student participation shall be purely voluntary. Students are not required to fundraise.
- ✓ Students that choose to participate will have total responsibility for the product. If it is lost or stolen, he or she must pay for that amount.
- ✓ It is suggested that the student carefully count all merchandise that is checked out prior to signing for the product.
- ✓ It is not necessary for a student to carry boxes of the product with him/her during the entire day. It is suggested that he/she pick up the product from me toward the end of the school day.
- ✓ Merchandise should never be left in lockers or unattended in a classroom.
- ✓ District Policy 6299 prohibits door-to-door sales by elementary students.
- ✓ Either the merchandise checked out, or the appropriate amount of money, must be returned by the end of the sale. Failure to return either money or merchandise will result in a fine and certain school privileges may be withheld until the fine is paid.
- ✓ Full credit will be given to the student for any unopened merchandise returned to me.
